Text: Genesis 39:11-23 Title: Joseph – The Prisoner

Introduction: Romans 8:38-39, Genesis 37:20, Genesis 37:28

Title: Joseph - The Prisoner who testified his relationship with God

1. Joseph's obedience to Potiphar's charge - Gen 39:1-6

- i. The Lord was with Joseph, v2.
- ii. The Lord gave him success in everything he did, v3.
- iii. The Lord blessed the household of the Egyptian, v5.

2. Joseph's fear of God - Gen 39:7-16

 How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God?, v9.

3. Joseph's life in prison - Gen 39:17-23

- i. The Lord was with him, v21.
- ii. The Lord gave him success in whatever he did, v23.

4. Joseph testified God's power - Gen 40:6-23

- i. Do not interpretations belong to God? v8.
- ii. Joseph was forgotten, how long? v23.

5. Joseph was remembered and out of prison - Gen 41:1-14

- i. Two full years had passed, v1.
- ii. Joseph was quickly brought from the dungeon, v14.

Conclusion:

Joseph had dreams; the prisoners had dreams; Pharaoh had dreams.
