SERMON OUTLINE

Title: Joseph – the saviour Text: Genesis 50:14-22

Introduction:

- God's promise to re-create, through Abraham and his family: Gen 12:1-3
- What family is this? Are they ready to be used by God?

1. Jacob's Family - Genesis 37-50

- i. favouritism, pride, hatred
- ii. alienation from father, family, land. A broken family. A family that needed healing before God can use them.

2. God's Family - Genesis 37-50

- i. God preserves Jacob's family.
- ii. reconciliation with father & family. A 'saviour' for many.
- iii. "you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good".

Conclusion:

God is all knowing, all powerful, and all loving. Look at the cross - Acts 2:23, 36.
