

"Let us also throw away every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus"

- Hebrews 12:1-2

### Introduction:

- Some things to throw away in our lives; so that we may faithfully live our Christian life.
- Jesus' Sermon on the Mount points to some baggage we need to throw away - anger, vengeance, greed, anxiety.
- To have emotions is to be human.
- Anger is a very common emotion.

## 1. Rightful Anger

- i. God's anger Exodus 23:6; Deuteronomy 9:8; Psalm 85:5
- ii. Jesus' anger John 2:13-22
- iii. Our anger Ephesians 4:26-27; Psalm 4:4
- 2. Harmful Anger Matthew 5:21-26
  - i. Beware of the 'heart'; not just the deed.
  - ii. Beware of the consequences; not just the desire.
