THROW AWAY ... REVENGE

"Do not take revenge on someone who wrongs you" [GNB] - Matthew 5:39

For reflection and discussion:

- 1. A church member wants to borrow some money from you. Would you lend? Why or why not?
- 2. Read Matthew 5:38-42. What do you think is meant by 'an eye for an eye; a tooth for a tooth'? In what circumstances is this originally applied? Ex 21:22-27, Lev 24:19-20, Deut 19:19 seem for the 'judge' to execute. It is meant to limit harm; and not to encourage harm.
- 3. Can this principle 'eye for eye; tooth for tooth' be applied personally? Why or why not?
- 4. How would you summarise Jesus' teaching in v39-42? Do you think they are practical these days? Why or why not? What is the main point of Jesus' teaching?
- 5. Read Romans 12:17-21. Why are we not to take revenge on those who have wronged us? What are we to do instead?
- 6. If a thief comes into your house and threatens the safety of the family; but, thankfully, he was overpowered and caught. What should you do? Discuss.
- 7. At this time of Lent, throw away bad habits and attitudes. Pray for one another; esp., to throw away revenge.
