Welcome to a gathering of God's people. We gather to worship the risen Lord Jesus and to encourage one another to obey Him.

2. EASTERTIDE

One of the immediate effects of the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the birth of a community, called the church. It began with 120 of Jesus' disciples on the day of Pentecost. It slowly, but steadily and surely, grew to be a worldwide community.

This Eastertide, we will look at some of the characteristics of this 'resurrection community'. Based on the letter of 1 John, they are:

- 7 Apr: Fellowship 1 John 1:5-2:2
- 14 Apr: Righteousness 1 John 3:1-7
- 21 Apr: Obedience 1 John 3:16-end
- 28 Apr: Boldness 1 John 5:1-6
- 5 May: Confidence 1 John 5:9-13
- 12 May, Mother's Day: Love 1 John 4:7-end
- 19 May, Pentecost: Power

Marks of the 'resurrection community' **FELLOWSHIP**

"if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another" - 1 John 1:7

For reflection and discussion:

- 1. What do you usually do when there is a power-cut (mati current!!)?
- 2. Read 1 John 1:5-7. What does it mean to 'walk in the light' and 'walk in darkness'? Give some practical examples.
- 3. What happens when we all 'walk in the light'? What does it mean to have 'fellowship with one another'? Describe a church where everyone is in 'fellowship with one another'. See also Acts 2:42-47.
- 4. 1 John 1:8-10. What do you say to someone who claims she has no sin? Or she has never sinned? Is it possible not to sin? Why or why not?
- 5. What do we do when we know that we have sinned v8? What does God promise us? Is there any sin too big to be forgiven? What can I do if I don't feel forgiven?
- 6. 1 John 2:2. What has Jesus done for us on the cross? How may we claim it for ourselves? If appropriate, pray for yourself, or someone in the group, for forgiveness of sins. Fellowship is sharing share prayers, cares and concerns.
