## 1. THANK-YOU FOR PRAYING

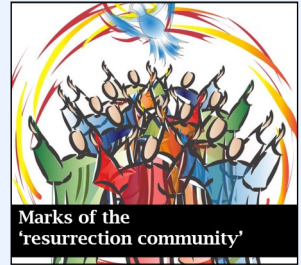
What a great week it was:

- Our EN youth (FAITH) had a most enjoyable camping experience. One of the leaders reported: "we went, sang, cooked, hiked, fellowship-ed and learnt God's word together. Some slept very little!". Most importantly, they learned how to make life's biggest investment - to follow Jesus. We thanked all the parents, leaders and helpers for making this event possible.
- The BM Diocesan Prayer Conference, Tawau, was very well attended; with over 2000 people at the nightly sessions. Our 50 participants went and returned safely. Everyone was fully charged (!), though tired (!!). We thank everyone, especially the drivers who spent hours on the road ferrying our people.
- Our EN young adults spent a memorable night at the Kokol hills. It was an occasion of meaningful interactions and mutual encouragement. Well done!
- The 150 participants at the World Anglican Chinese Clergy Fellowship, Taipei, were greatly encouraged by their experience. The Chinese work around the Anglican Communion is growing, albeit slow. Much challenges remain. The next gathering, in 2028, will be hosted by the Singapore Diocese.



## 2. EASTERTIDE

One of the immediate effects of the resurrection of Jesus Christ is the birth of a community, called the church. It began with 120 of Jesus' disciples on the day of Pentecost. It slowly, but steadily and surely, grew to be a worldwide community.



This Eastertide, we will look at some of the characteristics of this 'resurrection community'. Based on the letter of 1 John, they are:

- 7 Apr: Fellowship - 1 John 1:5-2:2
- 14 Apr: Righteousness - 1 John 3:1-7
- 21 Apr: Obedience - 1 John 3:16-end
- 28 Apr: Boldness - 1 John 5:1-6
- 5 May: Confidence - 1 John 5:9-13
- 12 May, Mother's Day: Love - 1 John 4:7-end
- 19 May, Pentecost: Power

4. Read 1 John 3:2-3. Share with one another what are our hopes in Jesus Christ? What must we do to keep our hopes secure in Jesus Christ - verse 3.
5. 1 John 3:4-6. What must we do to show our love to our sinless Saviour?
6. 1 Peter 1:15-16 - But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do: for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
