1. WELCOME


A warm welcome to Canon Robert & Mrs. Ruth Vun, Melbourne. We thank them for their ministries at both our CH and EN Services.

BOLDNESS

"Everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world" - 1 John 5:4

For reflection and discussion:

- 1. What are some of your fears? Creepy, crawling insects? Financial difficulties? Health challenges? Share.
- 2. Read 1 John 5:1-5. v1 what does it mean to 'believe in Jesus'? To believe in Jesus is to follow Him; to be His disciple. What does Jesus expect of His disciples? Read Luke 9:23. If following Jesus involves many challenges, why do we still want to follow Him?
- 3. We believe that Jesus was more than just a historical figure. What else do we believe Jesus was? vv 1 & 5. What do those two titles mean 'Christ' and 'Son of God'? What are the implications for us today?
- 4. 1 John 5:4-5. What does it mean to 'overcome the world'? Does it mean Christians will live a life free from illnesses, lack of money, misunderstandings and sufferings. Why or why not?
- 5. How may we 'overcome the world'? Read v5; and John 16:33. Christians live in view of the 'new heaven and new earth'. How does this perspective help us live our daily lives?
- 6. Share prayer needs, if any. Pray for one another to be 'overcomers'.
