Blessed Mother's Day JOCHEBED

The mother who honours God

"By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw that the child was beautiful, and they were not afraid of the king's edict." - Hebrews 11:23.

Texts: Exodus 2:1-10; Hebrew 11:23

Sermon by Dr. Lim Kar Yong, Diocese of West Malaysia

Introduction

- A mother who trusts in the Lord (Heb 11:23; Ex 2:1-2)
- A mother who raises children in the Lord (Ex 2:3-9)
- A mother who surrenders her children to the Lord (Ex 2:10)

For reflection and discussion:

- 1. How would you describe your mother? Share.
- 2. Reflect on the challenges that Jochebed, the mother of Moses, faced. What would you have done?
- 3. What are some of the challenges of being a mother in today's world? Let the mothers in the group share, first. Others may add in, later. How may we encourage mothers to be godly themselves; and to raise godly families?
- 4. How may we encourage the mothers in our wider community, in KK? How may we reach out to those with special needs? Share, Pray. Act.
