Today, on Trinity Sunday, we affirm this belief and pray 'may the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God (the Father) and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit; be with us all, evermore', 2 Cor 13:13.

Trinity Sunday
Being children of God

"For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God."
- Romans 8:14

For reflection and discussion:

1. How many people are there in your own family and in your extended family? Do you remember all their names, their birthdays, their hobbies, likes and dislikes? How different are each family member in their character? Share with the group what you can remember about your siblings' likes and dislikes.
2. Do your family members argue with one another? When arguments are heated up, who would step in – sacrifice their advice, offer help and solve the issue? Will you be one of them to step in and help in times of argument? Why and why not?
3. Please read Matthew 6:8, Luke 12:7. What does these two verses tell us about God? Read Romans 8:14 – What does the Spirit of God helps us as God's children? God the Father knows us and sacrifice His Son for us.
4. Read Romans 8:15. What do we receive from the Spirit? What do we call God now? How does the Lord's Prayer begin?
5. Read Romans 8:17 – As God's children, what do we become in Christ? How can we share in His suffering and glory for we are heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ?
6. Pray for yourself. Romans 8:14 – seek God's help to be led by the Spirit. Pray for one another in the cell group to walk with God.
