Give to the Poor

"When you give to the poor, it is like lending to the LORD, and the LORD will pay you back." - Proverbs 19:17

For reflection and discussion:

- 1. Describe someone whom you know is very rich. What makes you think he/she is rich? Describe someone whom you know is very poor. What makes you think he/she is poor?
- 2. There are many different types of poverty physical, spiritual, social, or in other manners. How does God view someone who is poor physically (materially)? Read Leviticus 19:10, Deuteronomy 24:15, Proverbs 19:17.
- 3. Jesus taught a parable about inviting 'the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind' Luke 14:13-14. What does this tell us about Jesus' attitude towards these people?
- 4. God blessed the Early Church. It grew very fast. What must have been one of the factors to this growth? Read Acts 2:45. How may we put this principle into practice today in our church? Give some concrete examples.
- 5. What are some of the ways the Diocese of Sabah been helping the poor and needy? How has our church been helping those in need? How can we play our part?
- 6. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19 as a conclusion. Pray for one another that God may prosper us, and help us to be generous.

MESSAGE FOR 2024 DIOCESAN WELFARE SUNDAY

Shalom, Brothers and Sisters in Christ. I bring you warm greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ from the Diocesan Welfare and Disaster Relief Board (DW&DR), especially during this Diocesan Welfare Sunday Month. I find it a joy and a blessing to be able to serve God and our Anglican Diocese through this meaningful ministry. Thank you for your gracious prayers and heartfelt financial support throughout the Year 2023 that make it possible for our Board to assist and touched many lives in one way or another.

- 1) The Seguntor Alternative Learning Centre, Sandakan & the Kundasang Community Learning Centre ran by St. Paul's Church, Ranau are dedicated to their educational ministry amongst the undocumented children of foreign workers. Our DW&DR Board will continue to support both centres with annual grants of almost RM100,000.00 inclusively. Let us pray for these students that they will excel and will grow to contribute meaningfully to our society.
- 2) Sabah Prison Fellowship our DW&DR Board has been giving annual grants of RM30,000.00 to support their meaningful work and ministry amongst fellow prisoners, past and present. Please remember them in prayers as they rehabilitate into our society.
- 3) Education our DW&DR Board has been receiving more and more One-off Student Study Grant applications since last year as we see applicants from different churches throughout our Diocese. This is a very good indication as our Diocesan priests are encouraging their young student parishioners to seek further education and a better future for themselves. Our Board has assisted another ten eligible and deserving students to a total sum of RM20,500.00 during Year 2023. We will endeavor to assist as many students as possible to fulfill their ambition within our annual quota.
- 4) Financial Assistance our DW&DR Board also provides various financial assistances to disaster-stricken members of our diocese. We had provided some funds for one family in Tawau last year whose wooden house had collapsed and needed materials for rebuilding. During the flood in the Nabawan area in October 2023, we provided Flood Relief Aids to four families who needed financial assistance. In the month of May 2024, we contributed funds to assist 25 families for their rice replanting work due to the recent drought in the Sook Mission District. Fire Relief Fund was also given to two families who lost their homes in a recent fire in Penampang. All in all, our Board had given out RM14,000.00 to those who needed help in times of need. However, I am sure that our Board can do much more to assist whenever our Diocesan priests bring forth the welfare of needy parishioners to our prompt attention.
- 5) Community related projects from time to time, our DW&DR Board will identify worthy project(s) to be implemented within the diocese to alleviate and remedy the personal, social and economic life of all Diocesan members.
