The God of Elijah God Provides 1 Kings 17

For reflection and discussion:

- Of all the birds that you know, which one do you like best. Why?
- 2. Share what you know about the prophet Elijah from your reading, Sunday School days, heard from friends, etc.
- 3. Read 1 Kings 17:1-7. If you were Elijah, would you eat the bread and the meat brought by the ravens? Why or why not?
- 4. Read 1 Kings 17:8-16. If you were the widow, would you have listened to Elijah? Why or why not? What happened when she did? What do we learn about God from this incident?
- 5. Read 1 Kings 17:17-24. What would you have done if you were Elijah? How do you describe Elijah's response to God, v20? Disappointed? Angry? Confused? Can we be angry with God in our prayers? Why or why not? Read Psalm 44:23-26.
- 6. From these 3 stories, what do we learn about 'the God of Elijah'? How does He supply for our needs today? Through the small or big matters in life? Through the natural or the supernatural? Through believers or non-believers? 'If God is not lord of all; He is not lord at all'.
- 7. Pray for one another; to have a greater faith in God.
