Exercise Our Faith Be Steadfast

James 1:12-18

For reflection & discussion:

- 1. Share your experiences of catching a mouse. What trap did you use? Did you eventually catch the mouse?
- 2. Read James 1:13. Does God tempt anyone? Why or why not? Does God 'test' someone? Why or why not? What is the difference between 'trials' (testing) and 'temptations'?
- 3. Read James 1:14-16. What is a temptation? How are temptations described here? How is someone tempted? Give some examples, from the bible or from your own experiences, how someone is tempted? What is the end result of temptations?
- 4. How may we avoid temptations? What resources can we call upon to help, when we are tempted?
- 5. Read James 1:17-18. What do we learn about God from these verses? What is God's will, according to v18? What is meant by 'first-fruits'? How are we 'first-fruits' of God's creation?
- 6. In light of God's will for us (v18), how should we respond? How may we live our lives as an 'offering' to God? Give some concrete examples.
- What has God promised to those who remain faithful to Him, v12? Pray for one another; esp., for those undergoing trials and temptations.
