- 8 Dec official retirement





Exercise Our Faith - James 1:19-25

Be Active

For reflection & discussion:

- 1. Sing, pray, read the bible, play a musical instrument, help someone in need which of these worship activities do you find easiest to do? Hardest to do? Why?
- 2. Read James 1:19-21. The word of God is liken to a plant that God plants into our hearts. How are we to respond to His word? [if you have the time, someone in the group may want to retell the story found in Mark 4:1-20]. What is the word of God able to do in our lives?
- 3. Read James 1:22-25. Summarise the teaching of this passage; which is also one of the major themes in the book of James. What is one of the ways in which we 'deceive ourselves', v22. How may we encourage ourselves to be 'doers' of the word, and not just 'hearers' only. Give an example when you obeyed the word of God. How did you feel? What was the result?
- 4. Read James 1:26-27. How do people show that they are pious? What is true piety, according to James? How do Christians practise their piety? What is the offering Christians bring to God when they worship Him? Read also Romans 12:1.
- 5. How would you help someone who says, "I have stopped reading the bible because there are so many things there I do not understand"? Close by praying for one another.
