

Exercise Our Faith James 2:14-26

Be Practical

For reflection & discussion:

- 1. What is your reaction when people need help?
- 2. How can the phrase "I will pray for you" sometimes be a copout? How can you make sure that you do pray for people that you say you will pray for?
- 3. Do you have a desire to share Christ with others? Or are you ashamed of Him?
- 4. Do you enjoy the fellowship of God's people? Is worship a delight to you?
- 5. James calls our attention to Abraham in Genesis 15 and 22. How did Abraham demonstrate his faith in these passages? (See also Hebrews 11:17-19)
- 6. James also reminds us of Rahab. How did she demonstrate her faith in Joshua 2? (See also Hebrews 11:30-31)
- 7. How can you better put your faith into practice?
