

Exercise Our Faith James 3:1-18

Be Encouraging

For reflection & discussion:

- 1. In James 3:5, we learn that the tongue is a small part of the body, but it holds great power. How far is the truth? Share your experience.
- 2. Read James 3:2. This verse tells us one sign of a perfect faith as Christian, is to be blameless in one's speech. One's word is never at fault. Discuss.
- 3. James 3:10-12 tells us that our words come from our sinful heart, and we are unable to control our words. Discuss.
- 4. In the past week, do you experience any encouragement from others through their words? What do you feel at that time? Share.
- 5. Nowadays, are we able to encourage or strengthen anyone with our words? Share. (We may start a commitment to do so, beginning in our family.)
- 6. Through the lessons in James 3:1-12, what do you think we should do to control our words so that we will be able to say good things and give encouragement to the listeners? Discuss.
