Welcome to our worship services this morning. We also warmly welcome those who join us online.

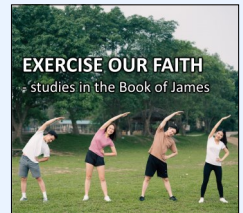

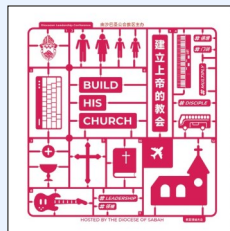
5. **MISSION TRIPS**
