'A New Comfort' - John 10: for reflection & discussion:

- GPS - 'guna pun sesat' (*I get lost, even when I use it*). Have you ever been lost? What happened? How did you find your way back/out?
- Jesus said that His sheep listen to His voice and follow Him (v. 3-4). How does God speak in bible times? And today? How can we recognize Jesus' voice in our daily lives? What are some ways we can stay close to Him?
- Jesus said, "I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved." (v. 9). What does this teach us about salvation ('being saved')? Why is Jesus the only way to eternal life?
- Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for the sheep (v. 11). How does this show Jesus' love for us? What does it mean for you personally that Jesus gave His life for you?
- Read Psalm 23; replace the 'I' with your name. E.g., 'The Lord is *John's* shepherd. *John* has everything he needs'.
- Pray for someone who needs the comfort of the Good Shepherd.
