1. WELCOME

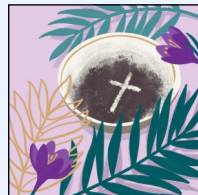

2. CHINESE NEW YEAR THANKSGIVING

17 Feb, this Tues, 8:00 am - **CNY Thanksgiving Service**. An occasion for us to give thanks for God's goodness; and to meet with friends, some of whom have returned from afar for the festive season. Breakfast will be served.

3. ASH WEDNESDAY & LENT

18 Feb, this Wed, 7:30 pm - **Ash Wednesday Service** (trilingual). All are welcome; including those from other churches. Palm crosses from last year will be burnt and the ashes imposed on the foreheads of worshippers as a sign of repentance.



The Service marks the beginning of Lent - a period of 40 days that emphasises on reflection, repentance, and, renewal. Spiritual exercises include:

- Noon Prayers - Mon-Fri, 12:00 pm-12:30 pm. Hybrid - in church and on Zoom. Three languages; conducted separately (different 'rooms'). Starts this Thu, 19 Feb.

- Fast & pray - discipline our bodies and spend more time in prayer.

- Give alms - set aside some money for welfare and charity.

'A New Life and Living' - John 11: for reflection & discussion:

- Describe an illness you experienced, or seen in others, that you found unforgettable.
- Read John 11:1-6. Jesus told His disciples that Lazarus' sickness would bring glory to God (v.4). What do you think this teaches us about trusting God when we don't understand what He is doing?
- When Jesus heard that Lazarus was sick, He waited two more days before going to him (v. 6). Why do you think Jesus delayed? How can we trust God's timing in our own lives?
- Jesus told Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die." (v. 25). What does this verse teach us about Jesus' power over death? How does this give you hope?
- 'If we lose hope for tomorrow, we lose meaning for today'. Do you agree? Why; or why not? Read 1 Cor 15:58. Pray for someone who needs the message of hope that Jesus gives.
