Parish prayer meeting TODAY - CH, Pavilion, 9:30 am; EN, Alpha Hall, 11:30 am.

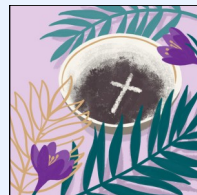

2. 'NEW REALITIES' - GROWING TO BE MORE LIKE JESUS

For the 5 Sundays in Lent, we will meditate on the farewell message of Jesus given at the Upper Room, on the night that He was betrayed. They are found in John 13-17. The topics:

- **1 Mar, Lent 2: 'Be Guided' - John 14**
- 8 Mar, Lent 3: 'Be Linked' - John 15
- 15 Mar, Lent 4: 'Be Prepared' - John 16
- 22 Mar, Lent 5: 'Be One' - John 17
- Holy Week & Easter: 'New Life' - happenings at the garden; rest of John's Gospel.

3. CONFIRMATION CLASSES

- 'Be Led; by the Holy Spirit' - John 14: for reflection & discussion:
- Do you believe in spirits? What kind - evil or holy?
 - Jesus says He will send "another Helper" (v.16). What does this passage say about the Holy Spirit? Who is going to send Him? What does this verse tell us about God, the Trinity?
 - Jesus promises that His followers will not be left as orphans (v.18; but He will 'come to [them]'. When did this happen? Read Acts 2:1-5. How does Jesus 'come to us' today?
 - The Holy Spirit teaches and reminds the disciples of Jesus' words (v.26). How does the Holy Spirit speak to us today? How can you be more attentive to the Holy Spirit's guidance in your daily life this week?
 - What does the Holy Spirit do in the world? Read John 16:8. Share some evidences of Him working in the lives of your loved ones; in the community; in the world.
 - Response: pray to 'be filled with the Holy Spirit'. "If you love me, you will keep my commandments", Jesus said.
