2. REALIGN & RESTART

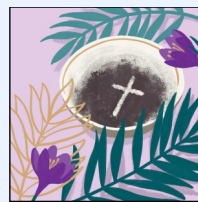
Lent prepares us for the Holy Week and Easter. It is a period to take stock of our lives and make the necessary amendments. Clear the clutter and start again. Some activities:

'Be Prepared; for tough times' - John 16: for reflection & discussion:

- If you were asked, 'why do you go to church?'; what would you say?
- Jesus tells the disciples that they will face persecution (v2). What would be some of the persecutions? Why do you think Jesus wanted to warn them ahead of time (v1)?
- Jesus says the Holy Spirit will come after He leaves (v7). According to this passage, what will the Holy Spirit do (vv8-11)? The Holy Spirit will bring convictions. Why do you think people sometimes resist being convicted about their sins?
- What else does the Holy Spirit do, (v14)? What is the main characteristic of someone 'filled' or 'controlled' by the Holy Spirit?
- In the face of difficult times ('persecutions'), how may we cope, (v24)? Whom can we depend on, (v33)? What may we experience when we pray and depend wholly on Jesus?

- pray that God may raise suitable leaders to serve the people.
