Today we celebrate the occasion when Jesus rode into Jerusalem as the 'promised king', the Messiah. He was welcomed by the crowd with palm branches. The children joined in the festivity. Today, we distribute palm crosses to remind us that Jesus' kingship was expressed through humility and sacrifice. He ruled from the cross. Let us follow Him.

'O, Worship the King' - John 12: for reflection & discussion:

- How do you like your next birthday to be celebrated?
- The crowd welcomed Jesus with palm branches and praise, v13. Why were they so excited? Who did they think Jesus was?
- Jesus chose to ride on a donkey instead of coming like a king on a horse, v14. What does this show us about the kind of king Jesus was? How does King Jesus reign?
- The proclamation, v15, is a quotation from Zechariah 9:9. What is the significance of this prophecy, as applied to Jesus? Who did Jesus claim to be?
- The Pharisees were unhappy, while the crowd was celebrating, v19. Why did the people respond so differently to Jesus? What does this tell us about their hearts?
- The crowd welcomed Jesus, but not all truly understood Him. How can we truly welcome Jesus as King in our lives this week? How may we serve as Jesus did? Pray that we may be humble.
