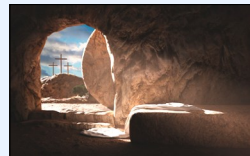

'It takes a village to raise a child'. May the whole church help to raise these children to love and to serve the Lord.

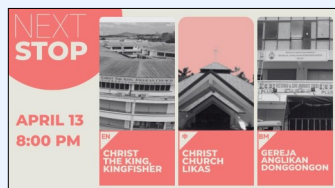
A warm welcome too to Pastor Margaret who has returned from her sabbatical leave.

'I have seen the Lord' - John 20: for reflection & discussion:

- a. Have you lost someone dear to you? Describe your emotions.
- b. Mary sees the angels, and later, Jesus, but still she was not affected by these experiences, vv.12-15. Why was this so? What might this tell us about grief, or pain and sorrow after the loss of a dear one?
- c. Jesus calls her name, "Mary," and she recognises Him, v.16. What is the significance of Jesus calling her by name? What does this reveal about His relationship with His followers? Read also John 10:3.
- d. Jesus says, "Do not hold on to me..." and then sends her to the disciples, vv.17-18. What do you think Jesus meant by this? How does this shift Mary from clinging to commissioning?
- e. Mary moves from grief to mission: "I have seen the Lord!", v.18. Where might Jesus be calling you to move - from sorrow, confusion, or holding on - to faith and witness? What steps can you take this week? How may we help people through grief?
