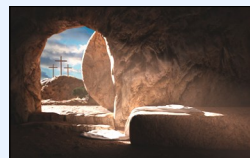

'Peace be with you' - John 20: for reflection & discussion:

- Have you ever felt afraid or uncertain about something and chose to stay "behind closed doors"? What was that like?
- The disciples were afraid, yet Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you" (v.19). What does this show us about how Jesus meets us in our fear and uncertainty?
- After seeing Jesus, the disciples were filled with joy (v.20). What changed them in that moment? Why does seeing Jesus make such a difference?
- Jesus says, "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you" (v.21). What do you think it means for believers to be sent like Jesus? What might that look like in daily life?
- Jesus gives them the Holy Spirit and sends them out (v.22). Where might Jesus be calling you to move from fear to peace, and to step out in faith this week?
