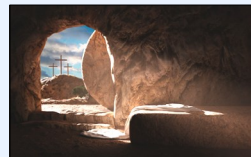

'My Lord and my God' - John 20: for reflection & discussion:

- 'Seeing is believing'. Do you agree with this statement?
- Thomas said he would not believe that Jesus had resurrected unless he saw and touched Jesus (v25). Why did he have this struggle? Did he lack faith? Or was he really wanting to find the truth?
- When Jesus appeared, He invited Thomas to touch His wounds (v27). What does this suggest about Jesus' way of dealing with earnest doubts? How may we help someone seeking for 'evidence' of the Christian faith?
- Thomas responded, "My Lord and my God!" (v28). What might have made Thomas change?
- Jesus says, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (v29). How do we encounter the risen Jesus today, v30-31. See also 1 Peter 1:8; John 10:3, 27.
