'IN HER HEART' - Acts 2:41-52 - for reflection & discussion:

- Share a good memory you have of your mother.
- At twelve years old, Jesus stayed behind in the Temple, listening and asking questions, vv. 42, 46. What does this tell us about Jesus' desire to know and engage with God's truth? How may we help our children grow to love God's Word?
- Mary and Joseph struggled to understand the full significance of Jesus and His mission, vv. 48-50. They grew in their understanding. How may we help our children to understand God more and more? And to experience Him throughout their lives?
- Read Luke 2:52. How may we help our children grow in a balanced manner - physically, academically, spiritually and socially? Share some success stories; and disappointing ones.
- Think of a Mum who may need your special love this week - someone lonely, struggling, weak physically or emotionally, etc. How may you reach out to her? Ask God; and obey.
