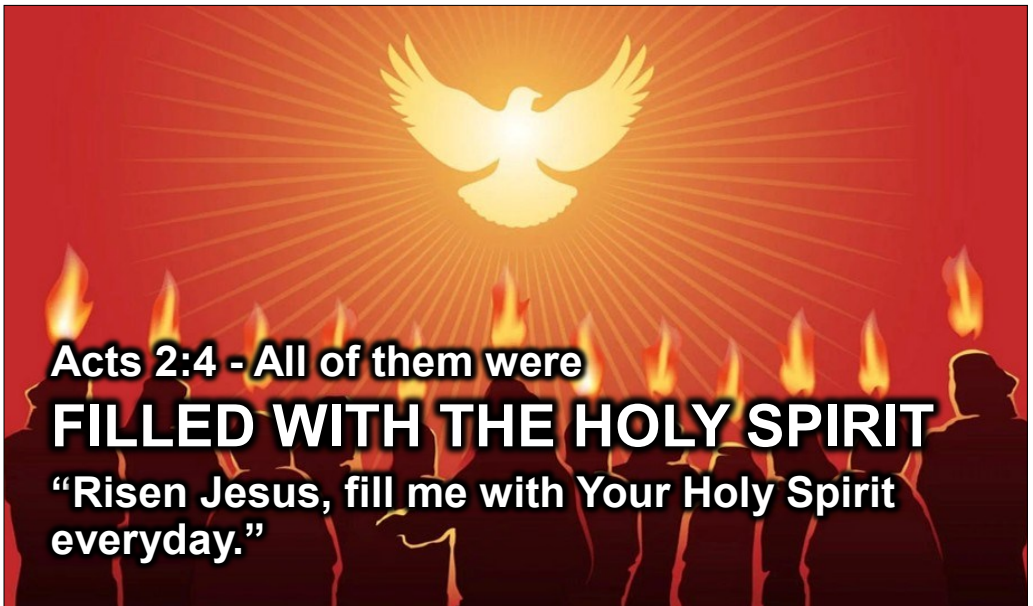
## Pentecost - 24 May 2026

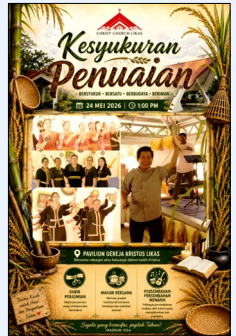
Welcome to a gathering of God's people.
