Matthew 28:16-20 - for reflection & discussion:

- When you hear the word "Trinity," what comes to your mind? What have you heard or understood about it before?
- V17 says, "they worshiped him; but some doubted." What does this tension between worship and doubt reveal about the disciples' understanding of the risen Jesus? How might this reflect the journey of faith today?
- Jesus declares, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me" (v18). What does this statement reveal about Jesus' divine identity and His relationship with the Father?
- Jesus commands baptism "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (v19). Why do you think "name" is singular rather than plural? What does this teach us about the unity and distinction within the Trinity?
- Jesus promises, "I am with you always" (v20), as the Church carries out His mission through the power of the Holy Spirit. How should a Trinitarian understanding of God shape the Church's worship, discipleship, and mission today?
