Psalm 100 - "Make a Joyful Noise" - for reflection & discussion:

- Mention one thing you are thankful for, today. Your health, wealth, family, faith, friends, etc.
- Psalm 100:1-2. Why do we worship with 'joy'? What if I don't feel joyful. Can I still worship the LORD? How do I make 'a joyful noise' to the LORD, besides singing loudly?
- '... all the earth', v1. Why is the whole world called to worship the LORD, v3? What do we know about God's heart and plan? Read Genesis 12:3, Matthew 28:19, Acts 1:8 and Revelation 7:9-10. Why should we be always concerned about world missions?
- "Know that the Lord is God", v3. From this verse, what two things do we know about who God is? How are we to respond, v4? 'Worship is our response to who God is and what He has done'. Do you agree? Or why not?
- V5 - three characters of God are listed as reasons to worship Him. What are they? Why are these characters important? Esp., when we cannot worship God with joy.
