Acts 2:14-24 - "The First Church" - for reflection & discussion:

- As far as you can remember, when did you start going to church?
- 'A Spirit-filled community'. What happened to the 120 disciples on the day of Pentecost, 2:1-4? Why did it happen, 2:16-18? Today, if the church is not a building, nor an institution, what is it? Who are the members?
- 'Worship Jesus as Lord'. What was the message of Peter, one of the members of the first church, 2:23-24, 36? What does it mean to declare 'Jesus is Lord'? How may we worship Jesus as Lord in our days? As young people? As older folks? See also Romans 12:1.
- 'Be Witnesses for Jesus'. What was the repeated message of Peter, 2:24, 31-32? We will never have the privilege of being witnesses of Jesus' resurrection. How may we show the resurrected Jesus in living in our lives and working in our church? Read also 2:42-47. What are some of the difficulties of practising these actions?
- Think of someone who needs the fellowship of the church. May be someone who do not know Jesus yet; or someone who has left the church for many years. Pray; and reach out.
