Acts 2:42 - “Devoted to Fellowship” - for reflection & discussion:

- a. At what stage of your life did you have your own room and not have to share room with someone else? Tell your story.
- b. The basic idea of ‘fellowship’ is sharing. One of the first signs of being Spirit-filled is a willingness to share. What did the Early Church share, Acts 2:42-47? Name as many as you can.
- c. Is it practical for us today to share what the Early Church did? Why or why not? What other things we can share today? What are some of the needs of our church members - physical, social, mental and spiritual? How may we share with them?
- d. The Christian life is lived in a community; never alone. There are many teachings on live with ‘one another’. E.g., ‘love one another’. What other ‘one another’ that you can think of? List as many as you can. See also Romans 12:16, 14:13, 15:7, 14.
- e. Coming to church is not just for myself; but for our sisters and brothers as well. Learn to share. How may we reach out to the new comers to church? Those who are shy? Those who have some physical disabilities? Suggest some practical ways.
