Confirmation is an occasion when a candidate publicly declares his/her commitment to follow Jesus. The Bishop prays that the Holy Spirit will 'make firm' (strengthen) the person in his/her faith. Where appropriate, the Bishop also welcomes those from a different denomination background into the family of the Anglican Church.

Acts 2:46 - “Breaking of Bread” - for reflection & discussion:

- a. Do you prefer rice or bread? Why?
- b. The ‘breaking of bread’ in the NT refers to 2 different, but related, activities. The first, is the sharing of a meal as a sign of fellowship and sharing. Read Acts 2:46; 20:7; 27:35. How may we share our food with others? In our culture, what is the significance of sharing food, or eating together?
- c. The second activity is the reference to the Holy Communion. Read Luke 22:15-20. The HC is also a ‘meal’ of fellowship, with Jesus and with one another. According to 1 Cor 10:16-17, what does the ‘one bread’ signify? What are some practical ways in which we can express the ‘one body’, here at CCL?
- d. In 1 Corinthians 11:27-28, a warning is given on how to receive the Holy Communion. How may we ‘examine ourselves’ before taking part in the Holy Communion? How may we help others to do so?
- e. How may we encourage one another to come to church and share Holy Communion with one another? What are some of the reasons people keep away from coming to church for the HC?
