Acts 4:1-13 - "Misuse of Authority" - for reflection & discussion:

- Share an incident where you have been unfairly treated. How did you feel at that time? How do you feel now?
- The religious leaders arrested Peter and John because they were teaching about Jesus and the resurrection, v1-3. Why did they feel so threatened by this message? As religious leaders of the community, what were their tasks? What does this show us about how authority can be misused?
- Peter made three declarations: i, the resurrection, v10; ii, salvation, v12, and, iii, being a witness, v20. Why was Peter so bold, v8, 13?
- What are some of the challenges of being a Christian in our family? In our work place? In our country? How may we be bold in our witness? Read also Matthew 10:16-20.
- Though Peter and John were "unschooled, ordinary men", they "had been with Jesus", v13. How does 'spending time with Jesus' make a difference in our lives? How may we be 'Jesus' people'?
- Think of someone facing difficulties in his/her Christian life. Pray for them. Reach out to them and encourage them. Be bold.
