1. **WARM, WARM, WELCOME**

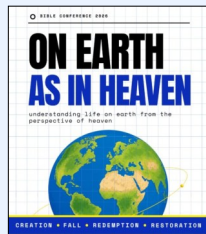
We warmly welcome into the family of the Church, the following persons baptised this morning:

Acts 5:1-11 - "Mistrust" - for reflection & discussion:

- a. If you were allowed to bring one (only one) material item to heaven, what would that be? Your handphone? Gold rings? Explain.
- b. Ananias and Sapphira sold their property, kept part of the money, and presented the rest as if it were the full amount (vv.1-2). The Apostle Peter asked them 3 questions, v4. What would your answer be to each of those questions? Was it wrong for Ananias and Sapphira to keep part of the money? Why, or why not?
- c. Why were their deception treated so seriously, vv. 4&9? What does the incident teach us about God's view of dishonesty and hypocrisy? Does it happen in such manner today? Would you like it to happen?
- d. Reflect on the sentence we repeat every Sunday: 'All things come from you, O Lord; and of your own do we give you', 1 Chronicles 29:14. What does this teach us about giving and offertory?
- e. How may we build greater honesty, transparency, and trust with one another in our church? How may we rid hidden motives in our hearts?
